

Mrs. R. Greenleaf Died Sunday At Canton Hospital

Mrs. Maren Young-Greenleaf, wife of Rodger Greenleaf of Canton and daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Charles G. Young of Elm Grove township died at the Graham hospital in Canton last evening at 7:25 o'clock.

The young woman's death followed a Caesarean operation which she underwent at the hospital yesterday afternoon. The child followed its mother in death.

Mrs. Greenleaf was a daughter of Charles G. and Bertha E. Lawrence-Young and she was born in Elm Grove township, May 16, 1901. She was a graduate of the Pekin Community High school and received her training in primary work at Western Illinois State Teachers College at Macomb. Her marriage to Rodger E. Greenleaf took place May 27, 1929 in Dayton, Ia. She was well known and highly esteemed in this locality and news of her death came as a great shock to relatives and friends.

She is survived by her husband, her parents, and the following brothers and sisters: Gilbert Young, Pekin; Mrs. Theresa Flemming, Macomb, and Susan Young, Pekin. The body of Mrs. Greenleaf was removed to the funeral home and this afternoon was taken to the home of her parents, five miles east of Pekin.

The funeral will be held tomorrow afternoon at 2 o'clock at Young residence in Elm Grove. Services will be conducted by R. Allen Miller and commitment will be in the mausoleum at Lakeside cemetery.
